

Making Cuyahoga County Stronger

With Healthy Communities

Total Cuyahoga County Population (2010): 1,293,825

Total State Population: 11,536,182



*Cuyahoga County's economy is stronger when everyone can participate in the economy. Healthy children become productive citizens, healthy citizens build strong communities, and healthy workers strengthen Ohio's economy. If Ohio extends health coverage in the state budget, **46,117 Cuyahoga County uninsured 19-64 year olds are projected to gain health coverage by 2015.***

This will ensure Cuyahoga County has a healthier and more competitive workforce and Ohio's economy will be stronger.

Health Coverage in Cuyahoga County

Total eligible uninsured adults* in Cuyahoga County (2010): 72,196

Projected eligible uninsured adults in Cuyahoga County in 2015: 26,079

If Ohio extends Medicaid, **only 2% of Cuyahoga County residents** would remain uninsured by 2015.

Projected Sales Tax Revenue if Ohio extends health coverage

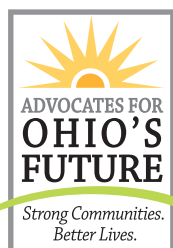
Projected New Revenue* in Cuyahoga County in 2015: \$6,488,696
